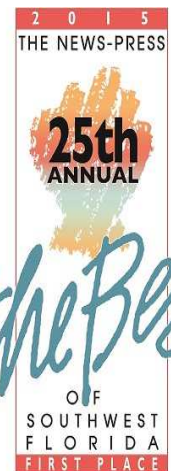

- Help your child practice their sorting skills with a deck of cards, sort by color, shape or number.

- Help your child find the letters of their name in newspaper headlines.
- Take a walk and talk about all the colors you see.
- When setting the table, add something that doesn't belong, ask them what the item is.

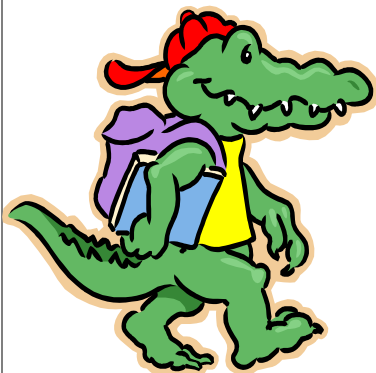
