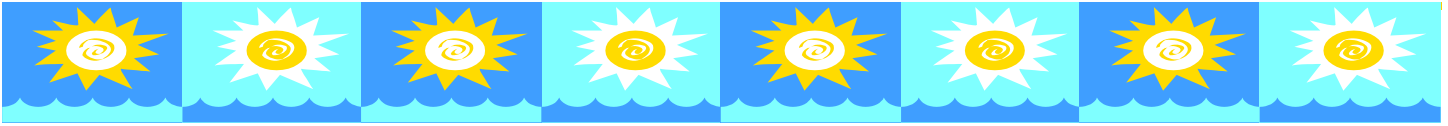


Kona Ice is returning this summer!! \$2 for a special treat every other Thursday! Ask the front desk for more information!

Developmental 2A

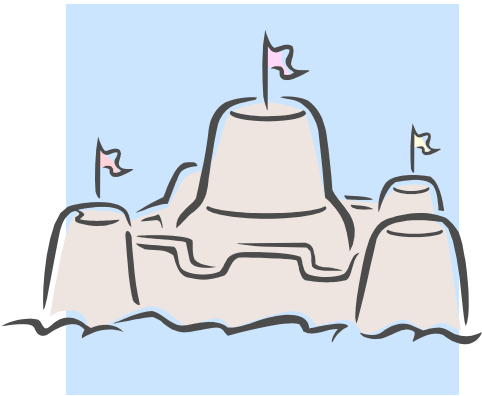
